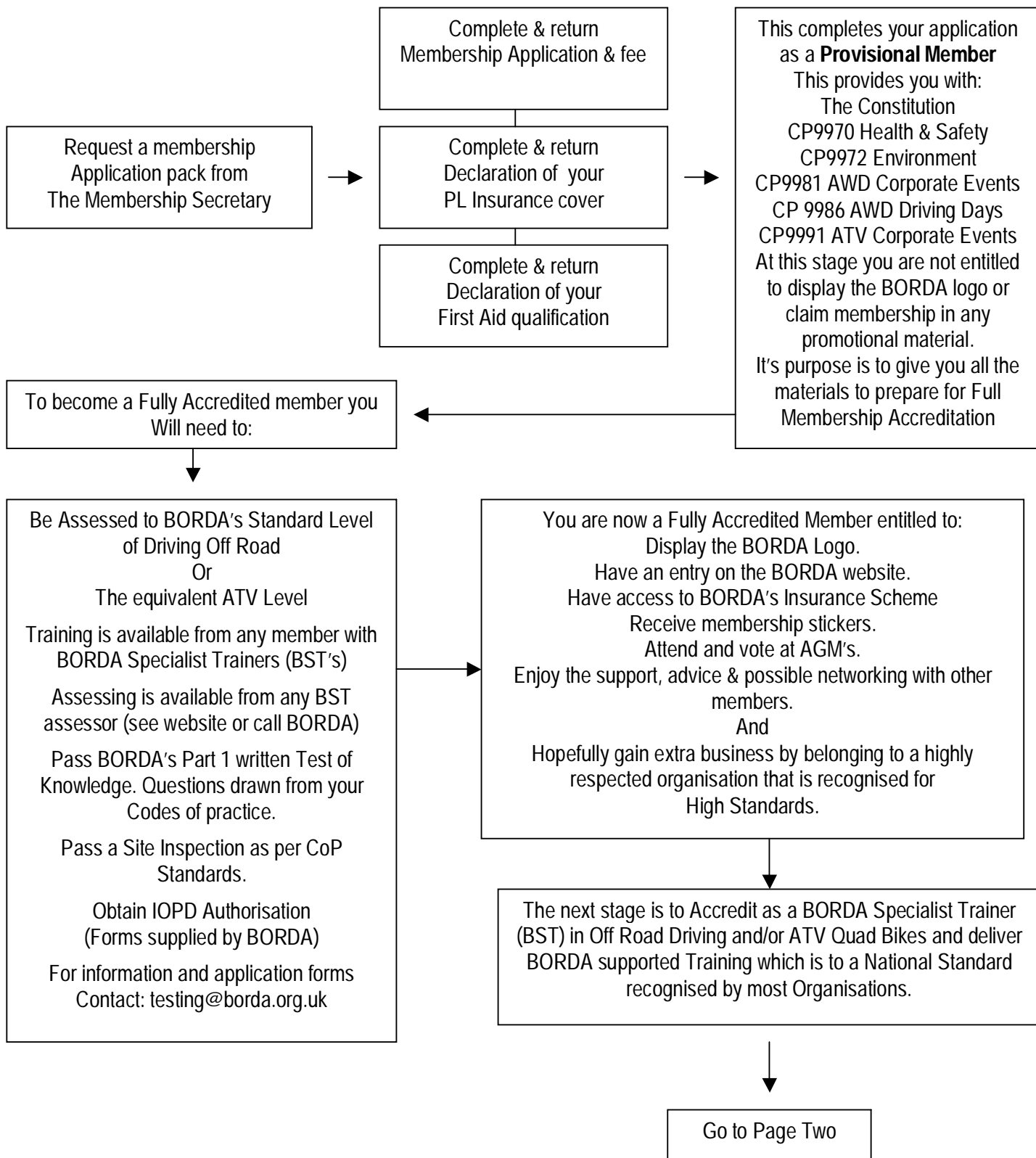


2008 Guide to joining BORDA



BORDA Specialist Trainer (BST) Accreditation

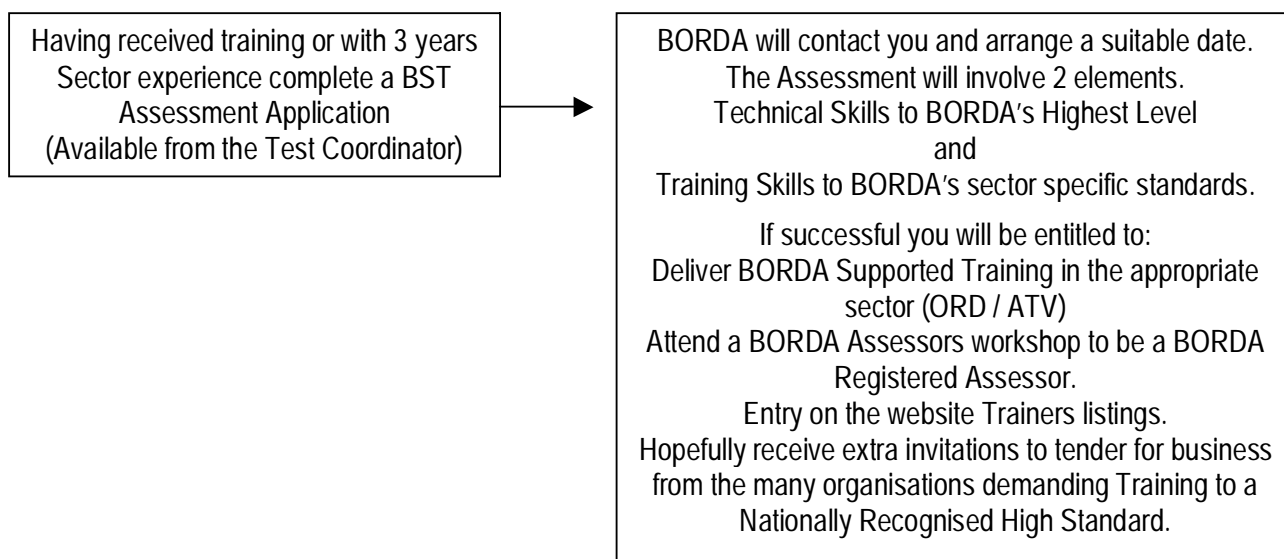
BORDA Specialist Trainers are accredited to BORDA Members, not directly with BORDA.

BORDA sets the standards and controls the final assessing.

There are 2 elements to Accreditation: Technical Skills (The Subject) and Training Skills (Training others)

Training for the Technical Skills element can be from any BST or equivalent and Training for the Training Skills element can be via a BORDA 2 day Train the Trainer Course or equivalent.

For candidates with a minimum 3 years Training Experience in the Sector we have a Fast Track assessment only policy.



FAQ's

What is BORDA's Purpose & function

- BORDA is a professional organisation looking after the interest of it's Members with well developed standards and expertise.
- Any Commercial Organisation that offers Off Road Driving Activity Events recognised by BORDA can apply to join.
- BORDA is a not for profit, democratic association with an Elected Committee
- Projects and policies are set at our Annual Meeting each year
- BORDA has a website to promote the Association and it's Accredited Members
- BORDA is Authorised under Statute 1371 of the Road Traffic Act 1992 through the International Organisation of Professional Drivers (IOPD) for Off Highway Motorised Events.

What Categories of Membership does BORDA have ?

- Provisional
- Accredited
- Associate (Non Operators but contribute technical work to BORDA)
- Affiliate (licensed to use BORDA's Codes of Practice but are not Operators)

How much does it cost ?

- Annual membership is currently £402 with a £30 discount for early renewal payment for Provisional & Accredited Membership.
- Part 1 test is currently £30 per candidate.
- Site Inspection is currently £250 repeatable every 3 – 5 years
- IOPD Authorisation is currently £35 per year.
- BST accreditation from around £125 if 2 candidates attend the same assessment.
- Training for Accreditation is not usually fixed by BORDA but a daily Assessor rate of £250 is suggested

What Training Events does BORDA offer the public

BORDA has Training Events for Off Road Driving in Conventional AWD Vehicles & ATV Quad Bikes Off Highway. There are two levels of Certification for both vehicle types, level 1 is a Certificate of Training issued by BORDA subject to a satisfactory Trainer's Report
And level 2 is a Certificate of Competence issued by the IOPD subject to a satisfactory Assessment from an Independent BORDA Assessor.

Are these Training Events Recognised ?

Yes, many operators specify BORDA Training and the IOPD, BORDA's authorising body, is the Governing Association for Off Highway Motorised Events.

What is the IOPD

The International Organisation of Professional Drivers is Authorised by the Secretary of State for the Regulation of Off-Highway auto events and Authorises BORDA and it's members.
